The press can be run at full production speed and up to 144 tabloid pages can be stitched.

The stitching system can be mechanically driven (with older folders) or equipped with its own drive. Stitched newspapers do not fall apart and they convey the feeling of holding a magazine, a sense of quality that boosts reader satisfaction.

Stitched sections and supplements convey more of a magazine feeling that gives your advertising department a very effective sales argument. ■■
